Additional possibilities

- ◆ **Transforming Churches** Workshop
 - 1 or 2 days
 - Typically on Friday – Saturday or just Saturday
 - For pastoral and lay leaders
 - Content
 - Introduction
 - Leadership on the Jesus Model
 - From "Come & See" to "Go & Be" (Becoming an outward-facing church)
 - Evangelism: Shifting from a Single Event to a Relational Process
 - Organizational Transformation
- ◆ Large Church
 - Allows a single church to create a custom international evangelism project
 - Multiple teams from a single larger church
- ◆ Outbound: Hungarian churches sending their members to other countries
