


DFW Departure Guide


When and where to be at the airport

British Airways (BA) departs and arrives at DFW Airport Terminal “D”. Your flight is scheduled to depart at 5:55 pm. The airline recommends that groups like ours arrive at the Terminal D lobby (**before security entrance**) at 3:00 pm.

BA counter is inside Entry D20 or D18. Across from the BA counter and between Entry D20 and D18 is an open area where we can gather. My wife, Janice, and I will be there and I will be wearing a blue golf shirt and tan slacks.

Check with Janice and Jerry

- ◆ They will give you your boarding passes for DFW-London and London-Budapest. You will get your return passes in Budapest.
- ◆ You will also receive an envelope containing 2 things:
 - Your cash *per diem* of \$65 to provide Thursday dinner (\$25) as well as Friday and Saturday lunches (\$20 each)
 - Your proof of insurance document that you should fold and keep in your pocket or purse. The insurance coverage is on the website at <https://tinyurl.com/CBA-HungaryInsurance>.

Check in with BA

- ◆ After you get your boarding passes, you may check in with BA to check your suitcase. You will need to have your passport available for the agent to review
- ◆ After you have checked in, you are free to go through security and into the large pre-boarding area. There a lot of shops and eateries there as well.
- ◆ You will have two meals on the flight to London: dinner immediately after departure and a light breakfast before landing. You are normally provided a snack on the flight between London and Budapest.

Some suggestions to make your way smoother

- ◆ Before you leave home, check that your passport is in a place where you can easily find it at the airport. Do not put it in your suitcase that you will check! If you are coming to the airport with a group from your church, show each other your passports before leaving town.
- ◆ Take something to read on the flights and while waiting in London between flights
- ◆ Get some sleep on both flights
- ◆ You arrive in London in Terminal 5 and depart to Budapest from Terminal 3. Stay with the group! You will see signs that look like this:



- ◆ Follow those signs to the bus that will take you from Terminal 5 to Terminal 3. You will go through a security check when you get to Terminal 3.
- ◆ After you arrive at Terminal 3, you will have a couple of hours between flights, so getting a snack might be a good idea. You will have to use British pounds (not recommended) or your credit or debit card (recommended).
- ◆ Watch the screens in the waiting area of Terminal 3 to see which gate you will need to go to for your flight to Budapest (BA 874). This will not be posted until about an hour before your flight. Your flight is scheduled for 12:55 pm, so you should start watching the screens pretty closely around 11:45 am.
